



PROTOCOL COVID WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS COMAPEDROSA ANDORRA 2021

This protocol applies exclusively to the Comapedrosa Andorra World Championships which will take place from 1 to 6 March 2021 at the Vallnord - Pal Arinsal ski resort, Arinsal sector.

This championships have groups 4 races:

- Sprint race,
- Relay race,
- Vertical Race,
- Individual Race

Which include the following categories:

- Senior Men + U23 Men;
- Senior Women + U23 Women;
- U20 Men;
- U20 Women;
- U18 Men;
- U18 Women.

This competition does not buy any amateur category. The event takes place under the image, regulations and control of the ISMF.

The competition will be spread over 6 days:

- 1/03/2021 → Opening ceremony
- 2/03/2021 → Sprint race
- 3/03/2021 → Relay race
- 4/03/2021 → Vertical race
- 5/03/2021 → Rest day
- 6/03/2021 → Individual race




In general, all interested parties (participants, organizers, technicians, service providers) must meet the requirements described below:

The use of the mask is mandatory at all times, whether by volunteers, members of the organization, teams and runners, only runners will be exempt from

wearing the mask during the races.

The regulations dictated by the decrees of the Government of Andorra on the cleaning and ventilation of the different enclosed spaces used during the competition will be followed.

The basic regulations to respect at all times are the following:

		
<p>Mandatory use of a mask</p>	<p>Wash your hands with soap and water or hydroalcoholic gel several times a day.</p>	<p>Remember to respect and maintain a minimum interpersonal distance of 1.5 m.</p>

Special press regulations:

- 1) The COVID people responsible for the event are:

- 2) Everyone who is part of the event must be previously accredited, without accreditation you will not be able to be part of it.
- 3) Accreditation will be given by the press officer (crodrigues@vallnord.com) in the press room.
- 4) To obtain accreditation, everyone must previously submit to the organization a negative COVID, TMA or PCR test performed up to 72 hours before the start of the event.
- 5) For press representatives who have to cover the individual race on Saturday 6/03, they must submit a negative antigen test on 5/03.
- 6) People with symptoms of Covid-19 are asked not to attend the event, to be isolated, and to contact their referring physician.
- 7) The press office has a capacity of up to 4 people, this capacity may not be exceeded at any time. If the space is busy, you will have to wait for someone to leave.



- 8) The press areas are delimited and monitored by volunteers, it is necessary to respect the areas authorized for accreditation, no exceptions will be made. In each area there can be a maximum of 4 people at a time, and there will be shifts so that everyone has access.
- 9) Interviews will be conducted respecting the interpersonal distance and with a mandatory mask. It will not be possible to have physical contact with the athletes.

Race development

Only duly accredited people will be able to access the competition areas. A special area for the public will be set up where volunteers and the organization will monitor the correct use of the mask and respect for distances. At the end of each test, participants will again be under the responsibility of their federations. No contact will be allowed between participants.

Acte de lliurament de premis

Only the first 5 winners in each category will take part in the awards ceremony, respecting 1.5 meters of distance between runners, a mandatory mask at all times and a ban on physical contact between runners. The awards will be given by: country authorities, ISMF management and LOC members.

Members of the press who wish to access the awards ceremony must be previously authorized by the person in charge of communication.
